ORDINANCE

SHORT TITLE:

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPECIAL SCHOOL

DISTRICT SPEED ZONE WITHIN THE TOWN OF

MONROE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MONROE, ADAMS COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Indiana Code 9-21-5-6(d) there has hereby created a special school district speed zone on State Highway 124 within the Town of Monroe within the immediate vicinity of the Adams Central School building located adjacent to said highway.

SECTION 2. The speed limit within said special school district speed zone is twenty-five (25) miles per hour during the times that special flashing lights are visibly in operation which shall be operated when school children are present.

SECTION 3. The boundary of the special school district speed zone shall extend from a point one hundred (100) yards west of the western driveway to said school building and extend eastward to a point one hundred (100) yards east of the eastern driveway entrance to the school grounds on State Highway 124 and when said special school lights are in operation the speed limit shall be twenty-five (25) miles per hour otherwise the speed shall revert back to the regularly posted limit.

SECTION 4. Speed limit signs designating the speed zone and the speed limits shall be erected at the western and eastern boundary of the speed zone and shall be in effect during said times as the lights are illuminated indicating the presence of school children and the effectiveness of this reduced speed limit for school purposes.

SECTION 5. The Town of Monroe shall notify the Indiana Department of Transportation of the imposition of this special school district speed zone by certified mail.

SECTION 6. Any person who violates any provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined any sum as applied to the conviction of a Class C infraction for such offenses.

SECTION 7. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
